### Lenten Principal Challenge

I hope you have been enjoying our monthly Principal Challenge for our Middle School House system. Typically, we have one challenge per month. As we prepare for Lent, however, we will be having a Lenten Principal Challenge over the course of two months. The purpose of our Lenten Challenge is to invite students to take advantage of opportunities to grow in their faith. Students will receive double the points of a typical Principal Challenge in March for successfully completing the following.

- Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once. (Non-Catholics are encouraged to attend a Penance Rite or take time to pray during a time that a Priest is hearing confessions.)
- Attend one weekday morning or evening Mass other than School Mass.
- Pray the Rosary (As a group, individually, or as a family).
- Attend Adoration and/or Stations of the Cross at least once over the course of the Lenten Season. Stations of the Cross during the school day does not count.

Parents and families are encouraged to take part in these activities. Students are asked to have their parents sign off on their engagement of all four activities.
