Below you will find the offerings for 1st and 2nd semester. The offerings for 2nd semester are tentative and subject to change. We want to give you an ideas of what will be offered to help you in your decisions for 1st semester.

Music is the only specials class that will no longer be required to take but it will be offered as an elective.
